## C. REPORTS / INFORMATION ITEMS

Principal's Report: John Di Vizio

- Report cards will be sent out digitally this Friday, November 10<sup>th</sup>
- Remembrance Day ceremony will be held this Friday, November 10<sup>th</sup> during periods 1 and 2. MPP Peter Bethlenfalvy, Mayor Kevin Ashe and school trustee will attend. Parents are welcome to join.
- On Wednesday, November 8<sup>th</sup>, Guidance Department will be holding college and university application workshops for grade 12 students during periods 1 and 2. Students will have lots of support throughout the process. Students can start to apply soon. This year only the OEN (Ontario Education Number) is needed to apply, so no need to wait for PINs.
- Ontario Youth Apprenticeship Program (OYAP) outreach days running in November and December for grade 8 students from our feeder schools. This program offers a look at skilled trades pathways.
- Initiative Groups Fair took place on November 1<sup>st</sup>. Unfortunately grade 9 students missed it since they were at "Take our Kids to Work Day". There will be a second fair just for the grade 9 students on November 16<sup>th</sup>. All 10 social justice initiative groups (Alliance for Compassion, Asian Canadian Alliance, Best Buddies, Domestic Outreach, Eco Team, Empower, International Outreach, Safe and Caring Schools, Students 4 Action and Unity/Black Excellence Committee) will be on display, as well as Enable, Student Council, and Athletic Council. It's not too late to join. Details will be posted on Instagram.

- 10 picnic tables, built by Mr. DiFonzo's shop class, have been placed in rear of school, in safe supervised area. They are already being used by students during breaks. Each table can fit 6 people.
- OSSLT (Ontario Secondary School Literacy Test) preparation is taking place with Mr McLaughlin for previously eligible students. Test will take place on November 28<sup>th</sup>. Grade 10 students will be taking OSSLT in the Spring.
- Motivational speaker, Sam Demma, will be coming on December 6<sup>th</sup>. Sam is a former St. Mary student and will be speaking to students about mental health, unpacking stressors, and how to move forward in healthy ways. Sam Demma has written a book, "Empty your Backpack", and has a podcast.
- Christmas Outreach will begin end of November.
- Congratulations to our Parent Representative, Zhora Adatia-McGlashen, who was nominated as Pickering Parent Area Representative for the Anti-Black Racism and Black Excellence Advisory Committee.

## Used Uniform Sale: Adele Sartor

- Last year we held a used uniform sale in January, during the Grade 8 information night. It was quite successful. We are hoping to do the same this year. The Parent Council will be using the Learning Commons for the grade 8 night this year. It is to be held on January 16<sup>th</sup>. The staff may require the Learning Commons for an Initiative Fair that is to be held for the grade 8 families. The Initiative Fair sections will be dispersed within the classrooms and throughout the school.
- It was agreed that Council should hold sale during Grade 8 night again this year (typically mid-January). Sale will be in library. John will look into availability.
- John will put out call for used uniform donations next week, and will follow up every couple of weeks.
- Parent Council volunteers needed to organize and run sale. Will also seek help from student ambassadors.
- Donated uniforms can be dropped off at office.
- Some Parent Council members were given a tour of the Mission Room, where there are currently some used uniforms available. Adele will send out an email with the current balance of used uniforms in the mission room closer to sale.

#### **OPEN QUESTION PERIOD**

Question regarding list to support students proactively.

Response: Unfortunately, the question is too vague due to there being various types of lists, including keeping track of: struggling students to help implement support, student academic success, student assistance for mental health support, support for students at risk of not graduating in time with their peers or who may be 2 or more credits behind their peers.

Question: Are there any special events happening in the school?

Response: There was a Halloween student movie night for Halloween on October 30<sup>th</sup>. Upcoming events: Arts & Music night; Student Council will be holding a semi-formal dance in the spring around Valentines Day. They are looking at the Audley Recreation Centre in North Ajax for the venue. The dance is for grades 9 through 12. The student council is currently in planning stages (most likely finger foods, would like to keep the cost within \$30 per attendee, no jeans etc.).
