Summer School Credit Recovery 2023 Registration Instructions for Students Attending a Durham Catholic Secondary School

- 1. Students are to fill out the attached Summer School course selection form with the assistance and approval of their home school Guidance Counsellor.
- Completed forms must be signed by a student's parent or guardian and returned to Guidance for processing and enrollment. You will not be registered until you return this form to your Guidance Counsellor. Guidance staff will then cross-enrol student into course selection.
- 3. Students who have not registered before June 29 will not be allowed to attend summer school without their school's approval. **Guidance Counsellor approval is mandatory.**

In order to take a credit recovery course, students must have taken the same course and level within the previous two school years prior to summer school and have achieved a mark of less than 50% (but not lower than 35%) to be eligible for a credit recovery course.

- There are no activity fees for summer courses.
- Students may register for one credit recovery course in each semester. A student cannot combine an accelerated high school credit course with a credit recovery course since the weeks overlap.
- Students will be expected to adhere to the standard rules of Academic Integrity and follow the Code of Conduct.
- Students will be expected to attend each day and meet all deadlines.

Students will be notified by email if courses are cancelled, but please check our website www.con-ed.ca for complete course updates. All course updates will be finalized by Friday, June 30.
