Principal's Report: S. Duane

Catholic Education Week and Mental Health Café

- An online mass was held during Catholic Education Week
- The Mental Health Café was hosted by 3 students it showcased student talent at St. Mary's and All Saint's – there was a guest speaker who was amazing – the event was a huge success with a large turnout
- There is a growing concern around the mental health of the students many students are anxious which causes concern around the return to school – the school recognizes that this will be a change in routine but feel everyone is ready to get back into the routine

Student Groups

- Alliance for Compassion Group (2SLGBTQ+) held a meeting with other high schools to discuss creating a safe place for students – students had a short amount of time but did a great job – other schools have reached out to the group to ask for help within their school
- Unity Group held a meeting to change the face of the school so that students will have a representation of themselves on the school halls – this group will design what goes on the walls – there will be flags from around the world and a large map which is planned to be completed by June
- Girl's Empowerment Group created a Mother's Day video which had teachers and parents talk about the importance of motherhood

St. Mary's is thinking about the roll out of used uniform sales – may be able to do something in late

Financial Report: E. Povolo

- Current balance: \$7343.02 \$1000 has been provided to the mental wellness café and \$2000 to the Christmas outreach
- There is \$2000 set aside for the grad gift and \$800 for the bursaries (4 bursaries at \$200 each)
- A request to double the bursary amount has been requested this would be an additional \$800 (4 bursaries at \$200 each) council has approved

NEW BUSINESS

Yearbook Investigation Update: S. Duane

- It was felt that the presentation from the Board did not address parent council's concern on how the yearbook incident happened
- The school has a tight process for the yearbook where a teacher is hired by the Board to oversee the
 process, there is also a committee of 5-6 people to oversee the quotes, and Ms. Duane also vets all of
 the quotes. The process in place was not followed.
 - A secured platform (Board approved) should have been used where all submissions would have been able to be traced to the individual submitting the quote
 - Identified inappropriate guotes during the vetting process should have been removed
- Unfortunately, the tight process was not followed last year
- There will be a yearbook this year with a couple of pages dedicated to the grads requests have been made to parents and students for submitting selfies – the Board has indicated there will not be any grad quotes going forward
