NEW BUSINESS

<u>Used Uniform Sale Q1 2017</u> B. Povolo

- -usually held end of school year
- -considering Thursday, February 9 as possible date
- -need to confirm inventory
- -discussed lack of kilts at sales (in past couple of years @ 10-15 kilts for any one sale
- -discussed limiting number of kilts purchased by one person? difficult to monitor/limited volunteers
- -issues with start time in past confirm and commit to start time
- -if February sale is confirmed, D. Ortiz will coordinate with Melissa re: advertising

<u>Fundraising Update</u> D. Ortiz

- -D. Ortiz thanked those who replied to her email to solicit ideas for fundraising
- -D. Ortiz also thanked T. Valookaran for his time in reviewing school focused/student led fundraising to ensure no overlap

Ideas for Fund Allocation:

- -Statue of Mary \$2000-\$3000
- -Sound System \$27,000 (gymnasium) currently have 1 of 3 required quotes
- -M. O'Brien confirmed \$5000 from Boyer Fundraiser will go towards this goal
- -D. Ortiz stressed need for a "magic" number of fundraising goal
- -next step would be to target fundraiser for that goal
- -Potential goal \$10,000 Sound System

Ideas for Fundraising

- -discussed pros/cons of organizing one large fundraiser
- -D. Ortiz felt not ideal, overhead cost risk of losing money
- -try smaller initiatives possible tag along with other school fundraisers:
- 1-Monarch Gear for purchase
- 2-Designer Bag sale
- 3-Consignment Sale
- 4-Bingo Night
- 5-Dance-A-Thon
- 6-Mardi Gras Night
- -reviewed calendar of school events currently going on or planned
- -Colour Run -potential to coordinate efforts with a portion of funds raised to go to Council
- -School Activity Fee discussed if possible to add on additional fee for "school improvement"
- -Notre Dame example \$50 ask (N. Sgro-Carpenter had put forward in email)
- -Non-Uniform Fee \$15 consider increase to \$20, with additional \$5.00 set aside for Council

- -discussed issue with keeping current units clean they are often filthy
- -open discussion about who can take on responsibly of keeping them clean
- -not the responsibility of those who work in the Café
- -currently, our Custodial staff are handling
- -discussed possibility of offering students volunteer hours to clean

3-Christmas Outreach

- -last year Council provided \$500.00

- -Council approved \$1500 for this year's Outreach
