



**Blended Learning Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT) and
American College Test (ACT) Preparation Course**



Course Description

This course will help students examine and identify their own learning styles, relate their inquiries and research to real-life situations, and investigate postsecondary educational opportunities (with a future career path in mind).

This course is designed for elite student athletes who are participating in an athletic endeavor and wish to obtain an NCAA scholarship; they will earn an Interdisciplinary credit preparing them for the Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT) and American College Test (ACT) in collaboration with persuasive essay writing, technology, and qualitative research methods.

Using the Desire 2 Learn Learning Management System, students will be more prepared for postsecondary education. They will become familiar navigating around this environment and as a result give them a hands on experience of 21st century learning.

This course combines expectations from Interdisciplinary Studies Grade 11, Open with selected expectations from but not limited to GPP30, ENG3U/4U, MCR3U, MDM4U, HHG4M.
