- You will choose up to 5 programs – no more than 3 programs at any given college
- You will accept your offer of admission on ontariocolleges.ca by the deadline assigned
- You may apply for OSAP directly on your college application

- Application Deadline for equal consideration is February 1st, 2021
- Application fee is \$95 and non-refundable (some vouchers may be available)
- Some programs have course requirements and/or additional items

Applying for OSAP (Ontario Student Assistance Program)

- Comes in a variety of forms: loans, grants, work study programs, scholarships
- Start application as soon as possible as a new user (or enter through college app)
- Combination of Gov't loans (must be repaid) and grant money (FREE!)
- Maximum is \$12,800 for the year, \$400/week
- Reduced \$ for grants, mainly loans
- No longer free tuition for < \$50,000 family income
- Use online estimator to get an idea of what you qualify for

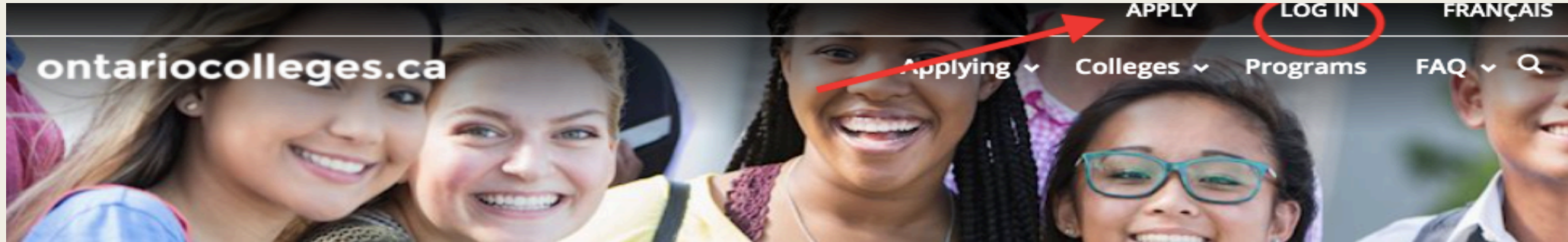

- ✓ Remember to use legal first and last name
(and ensure it’s the same in our school’s computer system)
- ✓ Accept the Privacy Statement

- ✓ Indicate that you "agree" to receive email messages
- ✓ Fill in both "Personal Info" and Education" – this can be updated at any time
- ✓ Once the Profile is complete you are ready to apply! Select "Apply to College"
- ✓ Enter the Program codes as found through your research using Ontariocolleges.ca OR research using the application site and a keyword search
- ✓ Remember to pay your fee in order to PROCESS your app!
