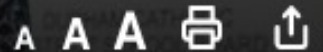
Grad Requirements

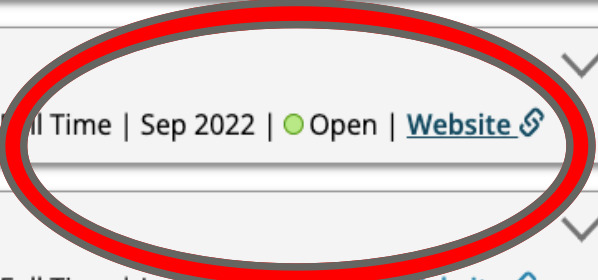

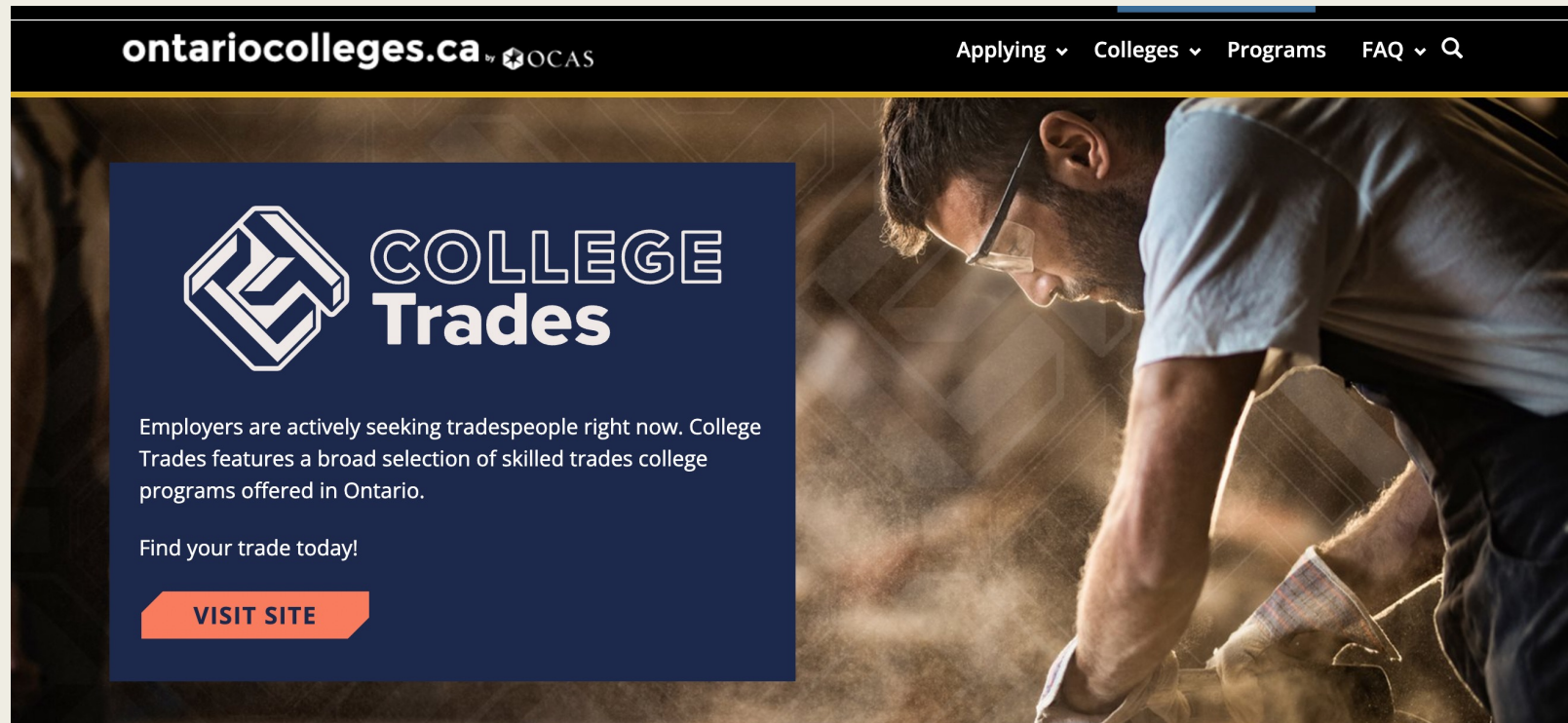

- 1 portrait drawing (not drawn from photo)

SELECTION PROCESS FOR HIGHLY COMPETITIVE PROGRAMS

Selection is based on an average of the four prerequisite senior level subjects (grades 11 or 12 or post-secondary) excluding co-op.

If subjects other than English are required for program entry, they will be used as part of the three other grades in the selection average if marks are available. If marks are not available for the prerequisite subject(s), you must currently be registered in the required subject(s) and your midterm marks must be submitted no later than February 1 for a fall start, October 1 for a winter start and February 1 for spring start. Marks for similar past courses will be substituted as follows:

- Grade 11 English substituted for Grade 12 English (C, M or U)
- Grade 11 mathematics substituted for Grade 12 mathematics
- Grade 11 biology substituted for Grade 12 biology
- Grade 11 chemistry substituted for Grade 12 chemistry or
- Grade 11 physics substituted for Grade 12 physics

If multiple subject credit marks are available, the highest mark will be used.

SELECTION PROCESS FOR ALL OTHER PROGRAMS

If subjects other than English are required for program entry, they will be used as part of the three other grades in the selection average if marks are available. If marks are not available for the prerequisite subject(s), you must currently be registered in the required subject(s). This will qualify to receive a “conditional offer”



A Few More...

- Remember to use a valid email address; correspondence will mainly be via email along with acknowledgement of receipt
- Include a correct mailing address
- You cannot make changes to your first and last name, OEN, date of birth or academic record. If something is not correct, notify your Guidance Counsellor immediately

- 2-yr Diploma program
- 3-yr Advanced Diploma (i.e., Engineering Technology programs)
- 1-yr General Arts & Science (GAS) programs
- 1-yr Certificate program
- Degree Program (requires six Gr 12 U/M courses for admission)
- Collaborative Degree (requires six Gr 12 U/M courses with opportunity to earn both diploma and degree)

Applying for OSAP (Ontario Student Assistance Program)

- Comes in a variety of forms: loans, grants, work study programs, scholarships
- Start application as soon as possible as a new user, application is now open
- Maximum is \$12,800 for the year, \$400/week
- Reduced \$ for grants, mainly loans
- No longer free tuition for < \$50,000 family income, but may be eligible for SAG
- Use online estimator to get an idea of what you qualify for

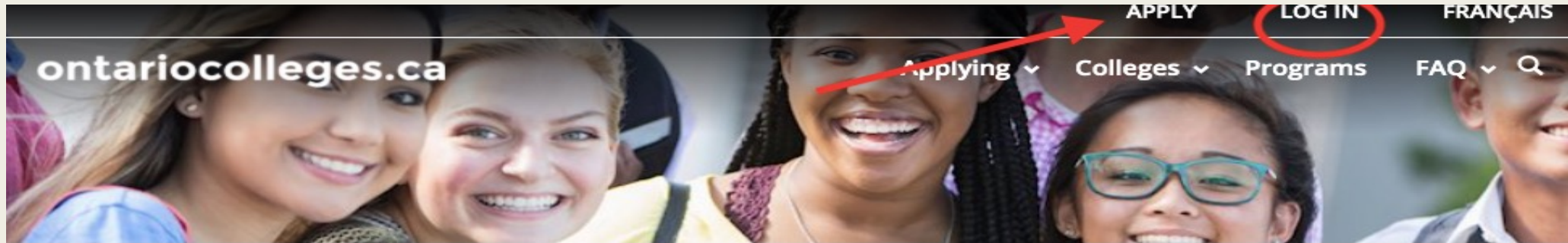

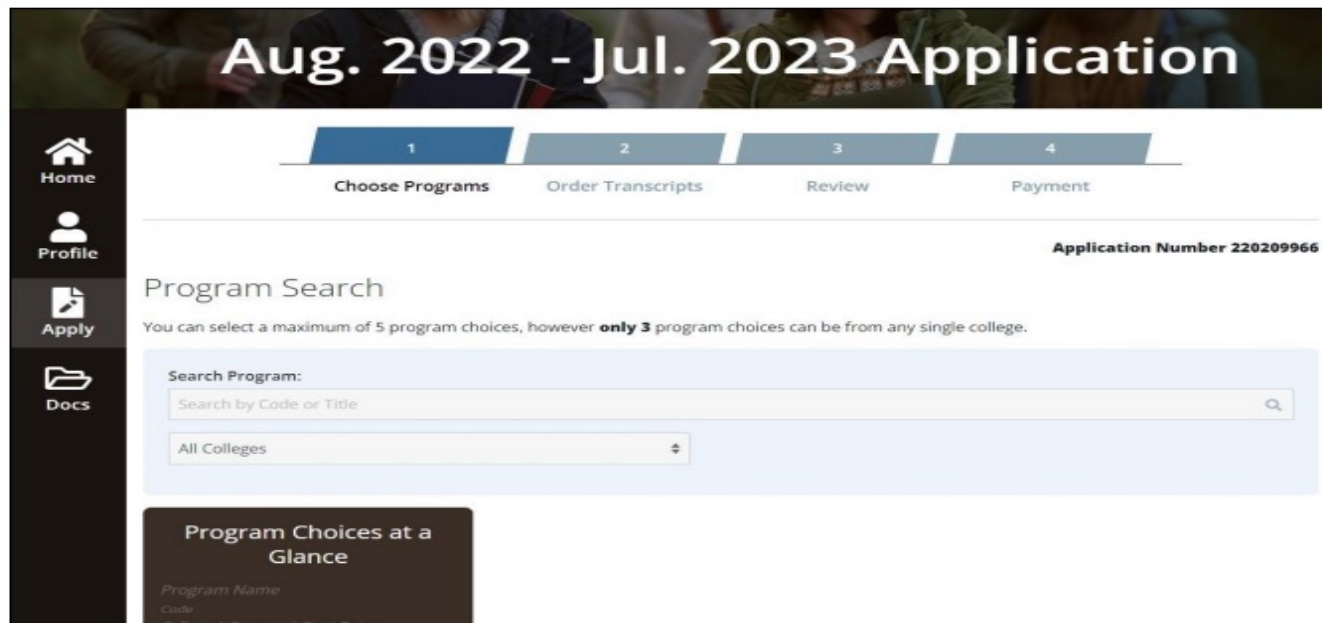


