Introduction

- ☐ Choosing courses consider post-secondary plans/past performance
- Remedial Summer School 35% required/2 wks
- Registration begins in April/May for Semester 1 courses
- ☐ Accelerated Summer School full month
- ➤ When you register for SS in April/May, you can adjust course requests
- > You must select course on planner and ADJUST later

Graduation Requirements

- 30 Credits (18 Compulsory) see your report card or your "course planner" for your personal "graduation requirements" summary
- OSSLT Spring next year
- 40 hours of Community Service, use <u>Log Sheet</u> to record hours

Educational Planning

- Should be working toward completing compulsories
- Note: Group 1, 2 & 3 have several options, Check Pathways Booklet for summary of grad requirements (pg 11)

Course Selections

- 8 courses + 2 alternates
- English, History, Math, Science, Religion & Civics/Careers are compulsory in Gr. 10
- Should choose Arts credit if not completed in grade 9, remember to choose the correct grade – Grade 10!
- CHC2D1 vs CHC2P1 (Choose 2D if you are taking ENG2D1)
- Plan ahead (check pre-requisites for Gr. 11/12 courses)
- Choose TWO alternates –these are in NO particular order and will be timetabled, if needed, without notice

- Religion HRE2OF
- History CHC₂DF/CHC₂PF



Course Types

The same as in Grade $9 - 5^{th}$ digit identifies the level

- Academic (D)
- Applied (P)
- Locally Developed (L)
- Open (O)

For English, History, Math and Science – must choose correct level.

Changing Levels – Transfer course required for Math (2week Summer course)

Civic/Careers & Religion are open






