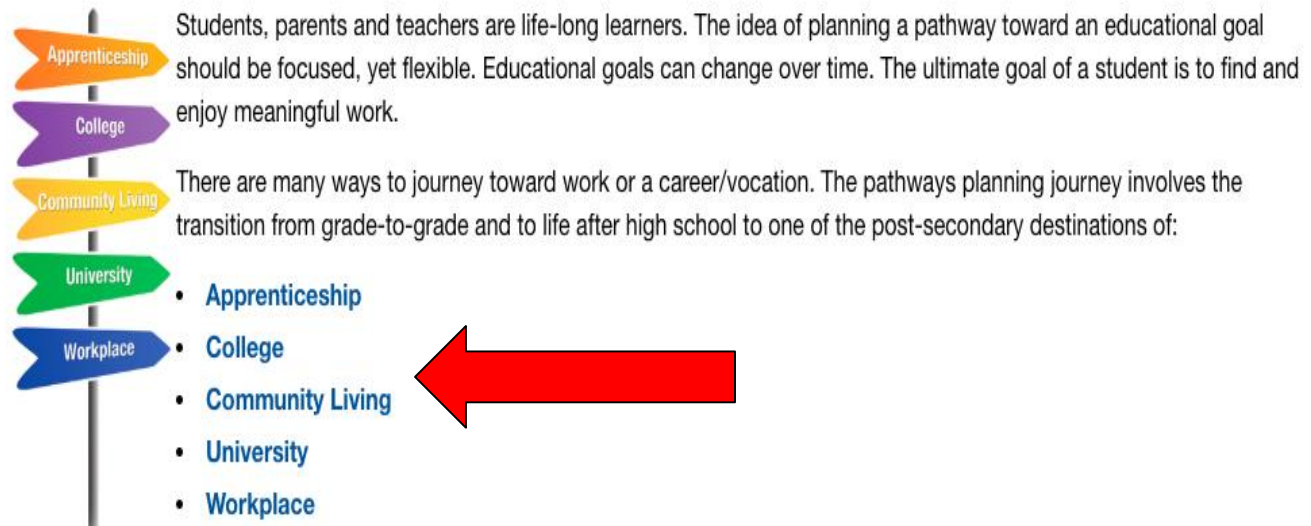

# Introduction

- Choosing courses – consider post-secondary plans/past performance (see **Post-Secondary Resources** at [stmary.dcdsb.ca](http://stmary.dcdsb.ca))
- Full disclosure
- Remedial Summer School – 35% required
  - Registration begins in May for **Semester 1** courses
- Accelerated Summer School – full month, in-class & elearning courses



# Graduation Requirements

- 30 Credits (18 Compulsory) – see your guidance counsellor or your high school planner for your personal “graduation requirements” summary
- OSSLT – usually late March
- 40 hours of Community Service



# Course Types

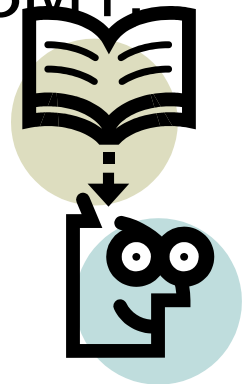
Most change in Grade 11 - based on post-secondary destinations

- Applied (P) is NOW College (C)
- Academic (D) is NOW University (U)
- Locally Developed (L) is NOW Workplace (E)
- Open (O)
- Mixed U/C (M)



# Course Selections

- 8 courses + 1 alternate.
- English, Religion & Math Required in Gr. 11
- FIF3UF required for French Immersion
- Some courses count as 2 credits ( co-op 2/4 credits)
- Choosing the right math: MBF3C1, MCF3M1, MCR3U1, MEL3E1 (see pamphlet)
- Religion – HRF3O1 vs HRT3M1
- Excellent marks? – may consider taking a grade 12 course

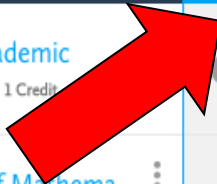

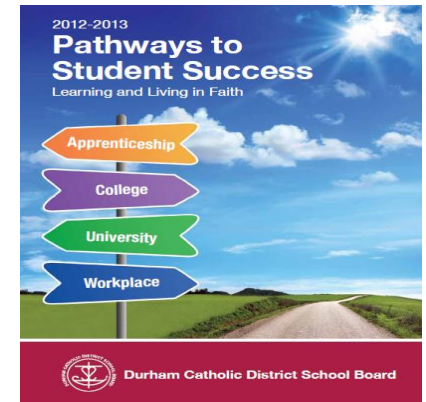
