Introduction

- Choosing courses consider post-secondary plans/past performance, aptitude, interest
- Check out <u>Getting Ready for Post-Secondary</u> to research programs of interest
- Full disclosure —all final grades/attempts in Grade 11 and 12 will be seen by colleges and universities
- Remedial Summer School 35% required
 ▶ Registration begins in May for Semester 1 courses
- Accelerated Summer School full month, in-class & elearning courses
- ➤ When you register for SS in March/April, you can adjust course requests
- You must select course on planner and ADJUST later
- Add a note in the "Comment" section when reviewing courses letting us know what you plan to take in summer

Graduation Requirements

- 30 Credits (18 Compulsory) see your report card or your "course planner" for your personal "graduation requirements" summary
- OSSLT usually late March
- 40 hours of Community Service, use <u>Log Sheet</u> to record your hours
- 2 Elearning Courses (Opt out option available –use this <u>link</u> to access the opt-out form)

Course Types

Most change in Grade 11 - based on post-secondary destinations

- Applied (P) is NOW College (C)
- Academic (D) is NOW University (U)
- Locally Developed (L) is NOW Workplace (E)
- Open (O)
- Mixed U/C (M) *geared toward university level of study

Course Selections


- 8 courses + 1 alternate.
- English, Religion & Math Required in Gr. 11
- FIF3UF and HRT3MF are required for French Immersion
- Some courses count as 2 credits (co-op 2/4 credits)
- Choosing the right math: MBF3C1, MCF3M1, MCR3U1, MEL3E1 (see math pamphlet)
- Religion HRT3M1 is your only option
- Excellent marks? may consider taking a grade 12 course
- Choose ONE alternate will be timetabled, if needed, without notice

 - -experiential learning
 - -2 or 4 credits (COP2/4O)
 - -<u>application is required</u> by the course option deadline
 - -application found on student dashboard in myBlueprint under "Resources"
 - -mature student ready to represent St. Mary at a place of employment

 - -includes a coop experience











Thursday, February 22nd, 2024


*There is no advantage to students for submitting courses before the deadline –take your time, but meet the deadline






