## WHAT IS ACADEMIC, REALLY?

Academic Level aims to:
$\square$ Teach essential concepts of a subject and explores related material
$\square$ Help you practice independent study skills
$\square$ Develop your critical and abstract thought
$\square$ Prepare you for future learning at the academic and/or university level

## WHY ARE COURSES BEING DE-STREAMED?

Research shows that de-streaming results in better outcomes for students and particularly for those who are from marginalized communities
$\square$ It creates more post-secondary opportunities and exploration for all students
$\square$ Gives students increased opportunity to enhance study skills for success at the post-secondary level

## ACADEMIC VS DE-STREAMED WHAT IS THE DIFFERENCE?

$\square$
Although there have been curriculum adjustments to Science, Math, English, and Geography and a change in course code ...there is no difference!
$\square$ All students will follow the same program of study
$\square$ Provides opportunity for students to make informed decisions about future pathway option for post-secondary studies

## LOCALLY DEVELOPED COURSES

Students are recommended* for Locally Developed Courses if:
$\square$ They may be working on significantly modified curriculum expectations in Gr 7 \& 8
$\square$ They are not yet working at grade level and require significant support
*Consultation with both Gr 8 teacher and Core Resource
