





### Academic Level aims to:

- ☐ Teach essential concepts of a subject and explores related material
- ☐ Help you practice independent study skills
- ☐ Develop your critical and abstract thought
- ☐ Prepare you for future learning at the academic and/or university level

## WHY ARE COURSES BEING DE-STREAMED?



Research shows that de-streaming results in better outcomes for students and particularly for those who are from marginalized communities

- ☐ It creates more post-secondary opportunities and exploration for all students
- ☐ Gives students increased opportunity to enhance study skills for success at the post-secondary level



## ACADEMIC VS DE-STREAMED WHAT IS THE DIFFERENCE?

Although there have been curriculum adjustments to Science, Math, English, and Geography and a change in course code ...there is no difference!

- ☐ All students will follow the same program of study
- ☐ Provides opportunity for students to make informed decisions about future pathway option for post-secondary studies

### LOCALLY DEVELOPED COURSES

Students are <u>recommended</u>\* for Locally Developed Courses if:

- ☐ They may be working on significantly modified curriculum expectations in Gr 7 & 8
- ☐ They are not yet working at grade level and require significant support
