- Teach essential concepts of a subject and explores related material
- Help you practice independent study skills
- Develop your critical and abstract thought
- Prepare you for future learning at the academic and/or university level

ACADEMIC ENGLISH

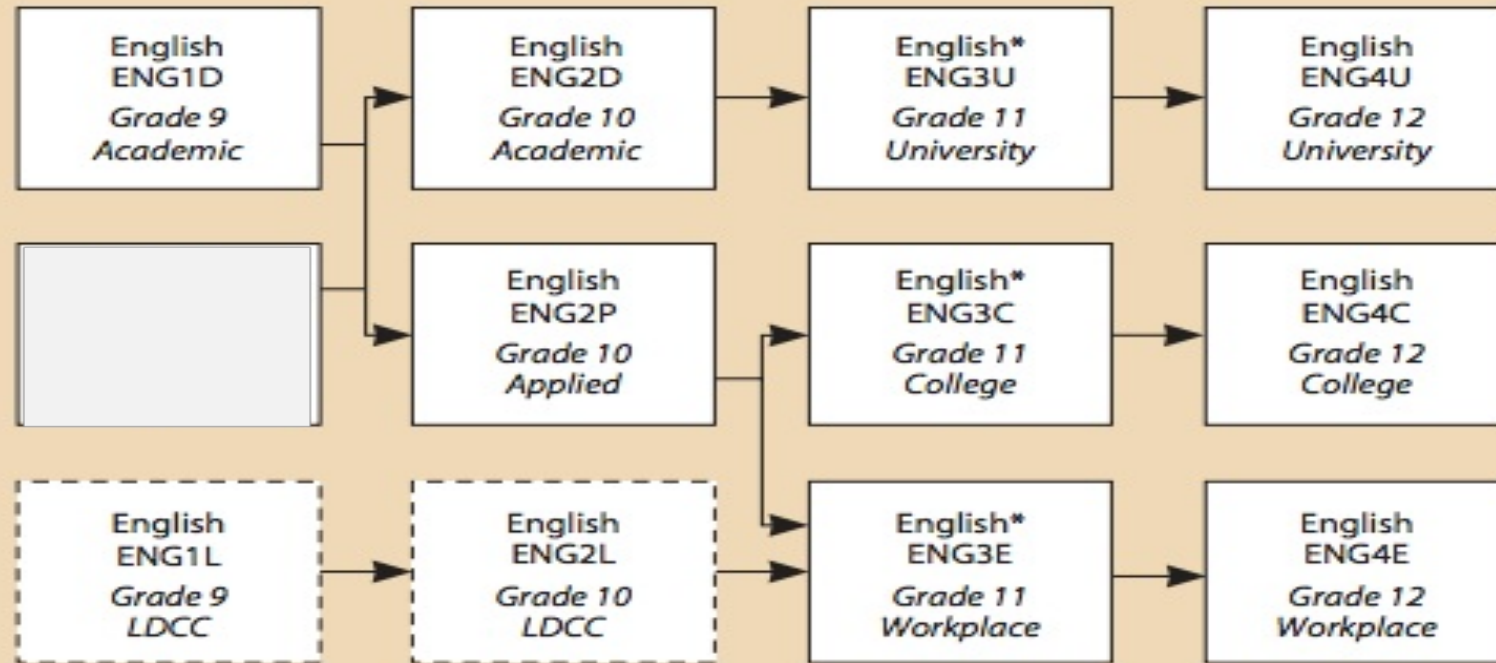
Will help you:

WHY ARE COURSES BEING DE-STREAMED?



Research shows that de-streaming results in better outcomes for students and particularly for those who are from marginalized communities

- It creates more post-secondary opportunities and exploration for all students
- Gives students increased opportunity to enhance study skills for success at the post-secondary level

ACADEMIC VS DE-STREAMED WHAT IS THE DIFFERENCE?



Although there have been curriculum adjustments to Science and Math and a change in course code
...there is no difference!

- ❑ All students will follow the same program of study
- ❑ Provides opportunity for students to make informed decisions about future pathway option for post-secondary studies

LOCALLY DEVELOPED COURSES

Students are recommended* for Locally Developed Courses if:

- They may be working on significantly modified curriculum expectations in Gr 7 & 8
- They are not yet working at grade level and require significant support

ULTIMATE POTENTIAL (U.P.) MATH

What is UP Math?

- U.P. Math is a remedial program that helps close the gaps in Math for students who are very close to becoming a strong Level 2 Math student
- Students are identified by the teacher and core resource

How do I select UP Math?

- Students choose courses on myBlueprint, submit completed registration form, and have timetable adjusted by Guidance at a later date.
- Click [U.P. Registration](#) for the form
- The UP Math course will replace one of your 8 courses in Grade 9; it will be scheduled in Sem 1, and then Math will be scheduled in Sem 2

UP Math will be added as a Reach Ahead option in the summer program prior to Grade 9

Students who choose this option, will not have to add it to their timetable for Grade 9


