

A Typical Day at St. Mary

~9am-3pm day ~Full uniform is Mandatory ~Semestered system ~75 minute classes, four classes each day with 5 minutes travel time ~Choosing 8 courses in Gr 9, five of which must be chosen at a specific level (based on achievement), plus ONE elective

What does our day look like now?

- -10:00am 4:00pm
- -full uniform
- -attending school everyday
- -completing two classes every 46 days
- -each class is 2.5 hours long

-3 lunches : lunch can be eaten in school or outside of school

Grade 8 Virtual Visit Day


We are bringing St. Mary to you!!
