
Applying to College for 2019-2020

Applying to College

- ☐You will research your program choices AND apply through ontariocolleges.ca
- ☐You will choose up to 5 programs no more than 3 programs at any given college
- ☐You will accept your offer of admission on ontariocolleges.ca by the deadline assigned
- ☐You may apply for OSAP directly on your college application

Things to Remember...

- Application Deadline for equal consideration is February 1st, 2019
- □ Application fee is \$95 and non-refundable (some vouchers may be available)
- ☐ Some programs have course requirements and/or additional items



More to remember...

- ☐Students must respond to an offer of admission by May 1st, 2019
- □ Apply to programs that are highly competitive by February 1st, 2019
- ☐ If a program is highly competitive it will indicate this on its program details page and/or through a filter option online

A Few More...

- ☐Remember to use a valid email address; correspondence will mainly be via email along with acknowledgment of receipt
- ☐ Include a correct mailing address
- ☐You cannot make changes to your first and last name, OEN, date of birth or academic record. If something is not correct, notify your Guidance Counsellor immediately

Various Program Options...

- □2-yr Diploma program
- □ 3-yr Advanced Diploma (i.e., Engineering Technology programs)
- ☐ 1-yr General Arts & Science (GAS) programs
- ☐ 1-yr Certificate program
- □ Degree Program (requires six Gr 12 U/M courses for admission)
- □ Collaborative Degree (requires six Gr 12 U/M courses with opportunity to earn both diploma and degree
- ☐ Bridging Programs vs Transfers/Articulations

- ☐ Complete your OSSD requirements
- ☐ Submit all additional application items
- ☐ Confirm your offer by May 1st
- ☐ All grades will be sent electronically by our Board for current students
