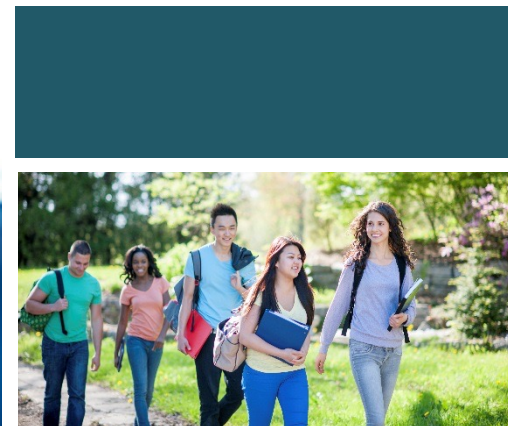

Applying to University



- Application will be submitted through Ontario Universities Application Centre (OUAC)
- Identify choices through OUAC, pay and submit application and then universities will send response email
- Use OUInfo as your primary research tool
- Check your application often for accuracy
- Ensure that all supplemental application items are complete and submitted ON TIME

Step 1:

Get Your OUAC Access Codes

You will have received a confidential letter containing your access codes via Canada Post mail delivery:

- **Temporary PIN**
- **School Number**
- **Student Number**

These numbers allow you to access your 101 Online Application.

IF you haven't received your PIN, please come into Guidance ASAP

Your PIN is confidential!
Don't share it with anyone else.

Step 2:

Research Your University Options

- Visit **OUIInfo** (www.ontariouniversitiesinfo.ca) to see what each university has to offer.
- Read the **101 Application Guide** (available at www.ouac.on.ca/guide/101-app-guide) for information about the universities and up-to-date program information.
- Watch helpful "How To" Tutorials for both OUIInfo and OUAC (how to apply, how to browse programs, etc)
- Check out university publications, websites and tours.
- Talk to counsellors, family, teachers and friends.
- Write down your program choices and codes, and keep them handy.

Basics to Remembers when Researching:

- Supplemental Applications – criteria and deadlines
- Applying early? – deadline for SA will be same for everyone (i.e., two weeks from submission) and some dates may vary...please check with your schools/programs of choice, some profiles may also be required through student portals, ie., SOLUS through Queen's

Let's talk “Early Acceptance”:

- Many think of this as a U.S. admissions model – this is NOT us!
- Early offers are conditional, universities will be reviewing all grades throughout the year, you must maintain your grades
- Do NOT have to commit to offer until June 1
- Don't make emotional decisions –make best decision for you!
- Equal consideration is Jan 12th –cut-offs will be determined as the year goes on
- Acceptance, decline, waitlisted, alternate offer

BASICS to Remember:

- Required Courses – varies with each program/school and entrance average
- Six (6) Grade 12 U/M courses, English mandatory for most programs
- Repeated Courses – most will accept greater of the two marks, some exceptions
- Specific Criteria re program choices – number of choices, ranking, faculty limit, coop option


BASICS to Remember:

- Summer School, Night School, Virtual Learning - all courses that are Ministry accredited and approved will be considered for equal admission, notify Guidance with both midterm and final (official doc req'd)
- Some schools/programs may discourage non-traditional courses and/or upgrades
- IEP/Accommodations – students must self-identify, visit Student Services on campus after applying to program

Step 3: Mark Your Calendar

- **October/November 2022:** Schools distribute Access Code letters for the 101 Online Application.
- **January 12, 2023:** Deadline to submit your completed application to the OUAC.
- **May 29, 2023:** Latest date you can expect a response to your application for admission.
- **June 1, 2023:** The earliest date you may be required to respond to an Ontario university offer of admission and give a financial commitment (e.g., registration deposit, residence deposit, etc.).



Once U of T receives your OUAC application, you will be sent an acknowledgment by email providing your U of T id and next step instructions in the application process.

If you are considering living in residence, you must complete the university's common residence application, StarRez. Details will be provided in your acknowledgment. Residence is guaranteed for all new full-time students entering their first year of a post-secondary program for the first time, provided that they have applied for and completed the university's common residence application (StarRez) by March 31, and have received and accepted an offer of admission by June 1.


Applied Science and Engineering - St. George Campus

Select only one program area. Applicants interested in alternate Engineering choices may indicate these on the Online Student Profile. All applicants must complete a student profile and pay the \$40 profile fee. All applications to the Faculty of Applied Science & Engineering will be carefully reviewed upon submission of the Online Student Profile, Engineering Assessment Fee and any required documentation. As part of the Faculty's broad-based admissions approach, the Faculty may consider OUAC program choice as a factor in admission decisions.

A 12- to 16-month PEY Co-op option is available to all U of T Engineering students. Applicants interested in this option will have an opportunity to declare it on their Online


