

Applying to University



- Application will be submitted through Ontario Universities Application Centre (OUAC)
- Identify choices through OUAC, pay and submit application and then universities will send response email
- Use OUInfo as your primary research tool
- Check your application often for accuracy
- Ensure that all supplemental application items are complete and submitted ON TIME

Step 1: Get Your OUAC Access Codes

You will have received a confidential letter containing your access codes via Canada Post mail delivery:

- Temporary PIN
- School Number
- Student Number

These numbers allow you to access your 101 Online Application.

IF you haven't received your PIN, please contact your Guidance Counsellor ASAP Your PIN is confidential! Don't share it with anyone else.




BASICS to Remember:

- Summer School, Night School, Virtual Learning - all courses that are Ministry accredited and approved will be considered for equal admission, notify Guidance with both midterm and final (official doc req'd)
- Some schools/programs may discourage non-traditional courses and/or upgrades
- IEP/Accommodations students must selfidentify, visit Student Services on campus after applying to program


Step 3: Mark Your Calendar

- October/November 2020: Schools distribute Access
 Code letters for the 101 Online Application.
- January 15, 2021: Deadline to submit your completed application to the OUAC.
- February 5, 2021: Recommended last date to make changes to your application.
- May 27, 2021: Latest date you can expect a response to your application for admission.
- June 1, 2021: The earliest date you may be required to respond to an Ontario university offer of admission and give a financial commitment (e.g., registration deposit, residence deposit, etc.).


If you are consistent in the providence, you must complete the consisty's common residence application, StarRez. Details will be provided in your acknowledgment. Residence is guaranteed for all new full-time students entering their first year of a postsecondary program for the first time, provided that they have confirmed their interest in residence by completing the university's common residence application (StarRez) by March 31, and have received and accepted an offer of admission by June 1.

Applied Science and Engineering - St. George Campus

Select only one program area. Applicants interested in alternate Engineering choices may indicate these on the Online Student Profile. All applicants must complete a student profile and pay the \$40 profile fee. All applications to the Faculty of Applied Science & Engineering will be carefully reviewed upon submission of the Online Student Profile, Engineering Assessment Fee and any required documentation. As part of the Faculty's broad-based admissions approach, the Faculty may consider OUAC program choice as a factor in admission decisions.

A 12- to 16-month PEY Co-op option is available to all U of T Engineering students. Applicants interested in this option will have an opportunity to declare it on their Online

Scholarships

Scholarships requiring application:

- Will require community involvement and other accomplishments
- Will have an academic component
- May ask for references (give your reference the courtesy of at least one week to complete)



Scholarships

- Check the Scholarship Report (electronic subscription compiling several awards during a 1-2 month period
- Check various web resources (see Edbsy post)
