SUMMER SCHOOL Credit Recovery Registration Instructions

2022 SUMMER SCHOOL Registration Process for Students Attending a Durham Catholic Secondary School

- 1. Students are to fill out the attached Summer School course selection form with the assistance and approval of their home school Guidance Counsellor.
- 2. Completed forms must be signed by a student's parent or guardian and returned to Guidance for processing and enrollment. You will not be registered until you return this form to your Guidance Counsellor. Guidance staff will then cross-enroll student into course selection.
- 3. Students who have not registered before June 29 will not be allowed to attend summer school without their school's approval. <u>Guidance Counsellor approval is mandatory.</u>

In order to take a credit recovery course, students must have taken the same course and level within the previous two school years prior to summer school and have achieved a mark of less than 50% to be eligible to register for a credit recovery course.

- Students need a computer and internet access to take an online course.
- Students working online will be expected to adhere to the standard rules of academic integrity and follow the Code of Conduct as is expected in the face-to-face classroom.
- Students taking an online course will be expected to log-in on a daily basis and meet all deadlines.
- Once students are registered and enrolled into the online environment, they will be able to access their courses:
