# Summer School Credit Recovery/Credit Upgrading 2025 Registration Instructions for Students Attending a Durham Catholic Secondary School

- 1. Students are to fill out the attached Summer School course selection form with the assistance and approval of their home school Guidance Counsellor.
- Completed forms must be signed by a student's parent or guardian and returned to Guidance for processing and enrollment. You will not be registered until you return this form to your Guidance Counsellor. Guidance staff will then cross-enrol student into course selection.
- 3. Students who have not registered before June 27 will not be allowed to attend summer school without their school's approval. **Guidance Counsellor approval is mandatory.**

In order to take a credit recovery course, students must have taken the same course and level within the previous two school years prior to summer school and have achieved a mark of less than 50% (but not lower than 35%) to be eligible for a credit recovery course. Students who previously passed a course and wish to upgrade their mark may also register for the two-week course.

- There are no activity fees for summer courses.
- Students may register for one credit recovery/upgrading course in each semester. A student cannot combine an accelerated high school credit course with a credit recovery/upgrading course since the weeks overlap.
- Students will be expected to adhere to the standard rules of Academic Integrity and follow the Code of Conduct.
- Students registered for Grade 11 and 12 credit recovery/upgrading must attend class <u>in-person</u> on the first day and all assessments, including the final exam, must be completed in-person. Students may work from home after the first day and on days where there are no scheduled assessments with parental permission (if the student is under 18 years of age). Students must be in Ontario for the duration of the course as VPN for the course work is not supported outside the province.

Students will be notified by email if courses are cancelled, but please check our website <u>www.con-ed.ca</u> for complete course updates. All course updates will be finalized by Friday, June 27.
