These programs allow students who are lacking the prerequisites in English, Mathematics or Science to upgrade their knowledge and meet the admission requirements.

Education After High School

Most college programs require students to have completed ENG 4C (College English) or ENG 4U (University English), but each year colleges add more programs for students who have taken ENG 4E (Workplace English)

Community Integration Through Cooperative Education (CICE) / College Vocational

Community Integration through Cooperative Education (CICE) / College Vocational is a two year program designed for students with intellectual disabilities or significant learning challenges.

Through supported college courses and cooperative placements the students develop the skills to improve their academic and vocational skills.

This program is not offered at all colleges so be sure to check your desired school for program availability.

CICE is a competitive program which includes an interview component. Applications are handled through the Ontario Colleges application site at www.ontariocolleges.ca
